We have distributed paper versions of the videos to all brigades in the Free Syrian Army. The Geneva Call, with the support of the Syrian Coalition, has invited FSA leaders to workshops at the Syrian/Turkish border, to learn about the rules of warfare. These six videos were used as educational tools during the workshops and as starting points for discussion about international and human rights laws and conventions. The Syrian Coalition strives to ensure human rights for all citizens, in spite of Assad's widespread violations of these principles.
