

**Your Excellency Mr. Mansour Al Otaibi**

**The Ambassador of the state of Kuwait and the Permanent Chairman of the Security Council,**

**Your Excellency Mr. Antonio Guterres,**

**The Secretary-General of the United Nations,**

On behalf of the revolutionary factions and civil groups in E-Ghouta, we dedicate our best wishes for success and accommodation in your leadership period of the Security Council, we would inform you that:

Depending on a meeting with representatives from, **Islam army, Al Rahman Legion, Ahrar Alsham and the Civil Activists Groups in E-Ghouta**, we report to you the following points:

The Free Syrian Army Factions are always concerned about the safety of armless civilians in E-Ghouta , they also demand repeatedly, to the necessity of respecting the international humanitarian law and the international human rights law, as they are also committed to the Conflict Roles that are dictated in Genève Accords and their two attached protocols, that Assad regime and his allies (Russia and Iran) breach them continuously, in addition to the intentional violations of the security council Resolutions which are related to the Syrian context, especially their bottles that target civil locations wilfully.

We seek to implement the related Security Council Resolutions, principally the adopting resolution 2401 (2018) that agreed on immediate ceasefire, and allow the United Nations Bodies to send some urgent relief convoy of aids to the besieged civilians in E-Ghouta, who are already blocked in the area for six years.

We declare the absolute commitment of all these factions to the honest execution of the council resolutions number **2254, 2268 and 2401**, as we declare that:

- 1- Our complete commitment to deport the armed groups of Tahrir Alsham, Jabhatulnusra, and Al-Qaeda and all those who belong to them, out of E-Ghouta during fifteen days starting from putting the ceasefire into actual force, according to an agreed synchronized mechanism in cooperation with the Office of the UN Special Envoy for Syria.
- 2- Our commitment to facilitate the UN organizations activities which work on sending aids and medical convoys that treat the injured and patients, we also adhere to protect these convoys and safeguard their crews all over E-Ghouta districts.

We affirm our concern to facilitate the intervention of the relevant UN organizations to control the implementation of the resolution 2041, so we acquaint your Excellencies with the regime and its allies (Russia, Iran and the co-fighting militias) violations and breaches, of the resolution despite our commitment to it. Accordingly, we demand that the United Nations and their bodies ensure the regime and its allies to adhere the following:

- 1- To stop all the hostile attacks and the military operations and the usage of any kind of weapons, as well as stopping the Air-Forces actions of the regime and the Russian Federation, in compliance with the UN resolutions 2254, 2268 and 2401.
- 2- Ensure the arrival of the relief convoys, and stop attacking the ambulances as well as protecting the medical crews that hold banners shown whom they are.
- 3- To allow the severe cases of injured and patients to access the medical points and hospitals in the neighbour countries and ensure their arrival via and supervised by The Red Cross, and ensure that they will never be exposed and targeted and will never be detained or captured, neither they nor their caretakers, in a case that they would be treated in Damascus hospitals.

- 4- To stop targeting the civilians, the educational and medical buildings and facilities, worship places, food Warehouses, power plants and stations, water desalination stations and all vital installations.
- 5- To organize secured, continuous and regular provision of the medical needs and sufficient food items in proportion to the population in E-Ghouta, which is **400,000 inhabitants**. The provision process through the crossing points should be under the supervision of the Red Cross and UN Human Affairs coordinator, a few of safe crossing points are already allocated by FSA factions. They are: 1- Al-Wafedeen camp, 2- Haeasta, 3- Al-Muleha Jesreen.
- 6- To allow the UN organizations and bodies to enter and operate in E-Ghouta under supervision of the coordinator of the UN humanitarian affairs.

We declare our preparation to discuss the mechanism that is needed to guarantee the immediate implementation of the Security Council resolution 2401, and fulfil the obligations of international law through collaborating with the special Envoy of the UN, or any other body authorized by the Secretary-General or the Security Council.

**Your Excellency Mr. Ambassador,**

We will be grateful if you give our message some of your precious time to read it, and to take the initiation to mediate in publishing it among the members, regarding it one of the council documents.
