Deir Ezzor City

Massive explosions shook the city as shelling on Deir Ezzor continued for the 74th day today. Shelling by the artillery stationed in the Talae'e Camp and the one on the Jabal (mountain) targeted most of the neighborhoods, most prominently:

- Hamidiyeh
- Al Haweiqeh
- Al-Jbeileh
- Sheikh Yaseen
- Muathafeen
- Al-Arfi
- Al-Urthi
- Al Qusour

MiG air jets specifically targeted Al Hamideyeh neighborhood today, which caused the destruction and burning down of many civilian homes. The destruction did not stop at the homes, but it also struck educational buildings; Thanawiyat Banat Al Olah (Girls' secondary school).

Communications (Landlines, mobiles and internet) are still down for most of the day's hours. This has been ongoing for over a month now.

Last night, 15 members of the Assad forces entered Al Qusour neighborhood disguised as members of the FSA, where they terrorized the citizens and executed four of them. Two of which (Rami Shweikh and Mohammad Al Jalbah) were taken to Al Saeed Hospital. The bodies of the other two are yet to be found.

::Sfeirah Tahtani::

Massacre in Sfeirah Tahtani –

MiG aircrafts of the Assad regime bombarded the town of Sfeirah Tahtani. This resulted in the complete destruction of 3 homes that belong to one extended family.

Until this moment 3 children have been extracted from beneath the rubble. They are:

1-Qatana Hussein Al-Alwan Al-Khider, young girl

2-Mohammad Hussein Al-Alwan Al-Khider, young boy

3-Fayhaa Saleh Al-Alwan Al-Khider, young girl

4 other children are wounded. The search for more victims of this barbaric attack continues.

::Abu Kamal::

The disaster-stricken city of Abu Kamal has been subjected to intense shelling by military aircrafts, which targeted most of the areas in it, including residential areas like:

- Al-Jameyat Neighborhood

- Al-Tuwayba Neighborhood

- Al-Masakin Neighborhood

- Al-Sakin Neighborhood

The city was also hit with mortar shells from artillery, which resulted in many injuries, some of which were severe. The bombardment of the city has also led to the destruction and collapse of several homes.

The regime forces are stationed at 3 main locations:

1-The security quadrangle, which is composed of the Military Security, State Security and the army points

2-The bridge connecting the city and the rural areas

3-Hamdan Airport, which is the source of the shells that bombard the city. It is incredibly reinforced and fortified.

The city of Abu Kamal is completely disaster-stricken, for the buildings have been affected

by the shelling, and some have completely collapsed, the main trade market was destroyed.

There is no milk for babies and there is a severe lack in basic foods and all kinds of medical supplies. The number of migrants is rising as a result of the closure of the Iraqi border at the crossing with Abu Kamal, even the wounded are not allowed to cross for treatment.

::Al-Husseiniyeh::

The village of Al-Husseiniyeh was subjected to intense shelling and military helicopters were spotted flying above it. Helicopters were also seen flying along the line of villages in the vicinity of Al-Husseiniyeh. One of the military helicopters over Al-Husseiniyeh fired a missile onto the village and opened fire from its machine guns at the orchards and homes. Then a TNT barrel was dropped from it into one of the fields, which resulted in a massive explosion that was heard throughout the village.

Shelling was then carried out by artillery stationed in Talae'e Camp, and resulted in the closure of the road between Deir Ezzor-Hasaka.

Al-Husseiniyeh, which is roughly 5km north of Deir Ezzor City, suffers from awful conditions: there is a shortage in bread, baby's milk, basic foods, medicine and medical staff. Inhabitants of the village are forced to take their injured to neighboring areas. The village is also home to many of the people who migrated from Deir Ezzor City.

::Aayish::

The town of Ayish was bombarded by artillery, among the shells that fell on the town, more than 4 dropped near Al-Ali Al-Hassan Mosque.

Other parts of rural Deir Ezzor that were subjected to fierce shelling by artillery include Al-Salhiyyeh, Mheimedeh and Al-Hussan (الحصان).
