

Judgment of the Court (Eighth Chamber) of 1 October 2020 – Cham Holding Co. SA v Council of the European Union

(Case C-261/19 P)¹

(Appeal – Common foreign and security policy – Restrictive measures taken against the Syrian Arab Republic – Measures directed against certain persons and entities engaged in activities in Syria – List of persons and entities subject to the freezing of funds and economic resources – Inclusion of the appellant’s name – Action for annulment)
